- Newspaper
- Aluminum Cans
- Corrugated Boxes
- Paper Grocery Bags
- Junk Mail & Magazines
- Glass Jars, Glass Bottles
- Empty Plastic Grocery Bags
- Plastic Bottles & Jars #1 & #2
- Ceramics, Pyrex, Window Glass
(Window Glass only, no window frames)
- Cereal & Other Paste Board Boxes
- Steel Food Cans & Steel Beverage Cans



We Cannot Recycle



- No Mirrors
- No Batteries
- No Auto Glass
- No Light Bulbs
- No Anti- Freeze
- No Used Motor Oil
- No Transmission Oil
- No Lead Crystal Glass
- No Polystyrene (Styrofoam)

Please help make recycling happen by preparing your recyclable materials as requested. What can be recycled and how these materials have to be prepared is determined by the businesses that make products from recycled materials. Careful preparation and separation of recyclables is important. Manufacturers require clean and contaminant free materials to make new products. Unsorted or improperly prepared materials go to the landfill.

Please, no trash. Non-recyclable items will be left in recycling container. Please dispose with garbage.

The recycling container is the responsibility of the home owner. If you move, the recycling container must remain on the property.

Industrial

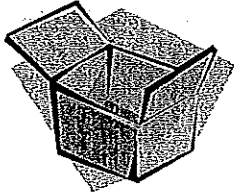

How to Prepare and Separate Your Recyclables

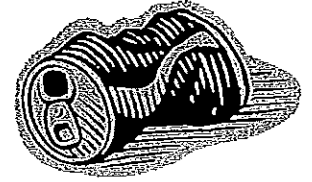
Corrugated Cardboard

- Remove packing materials, such as foam, peanuts, & bubble wrap.
- All paste board boxes must have wax liner removed.
- Flatten boxes and place beneath recycling container.
- Cereal boxes are ok.
- NO juice containers.



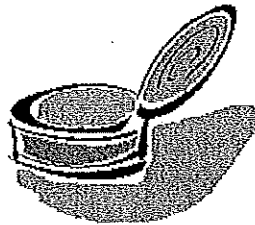
Beverage Cans

- Please drain completely.
- Aluminum & steel beverage cans will be separated automatically at the Recycling Center.
- You may flatten cans to save space for home storage.



Steel Food Cans

- Rinse clean.
- Paper labels ok.
- Place lid inside can and pinch end closed to keep lid inside.



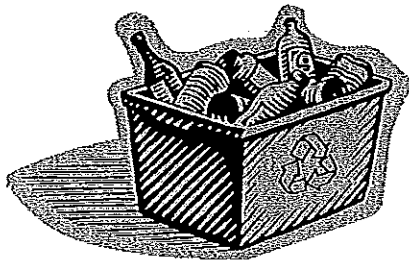
Newspaper

- Stack in brown paper grocery bags.
- Do not pack in plastic bags or tie in bundles
- Loose newspaper can cause litter.
- Shiny paper is ok.



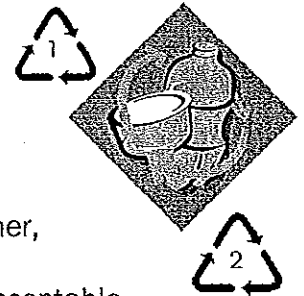
Glass Jars & Bottles ONLY!

- Throw away caps & lids.
- Must rinse clean.
- Paper labels do not have to be removed.
- No window frames with window glass.
- No china, dishes, safety glass, lead crystal glass, light bulbs, or mirrors.



Plastic Bottles & Jars

- Throw away caps.
- Must rinse bottles clean.
- Acceptable
 - Clear pop bottles
 - Green pop bottles
 - White milk & water jugs
 - Colored detergent, softener, & bleach bottles
- Only #1 & #2 plastic is acceptable
- No motor oil, transmission oil, or anti-freeze containers.



Scrap Aluminum

- Aluminum foil, pie & dinner trays, aluminum lawn furniture are ok.
- Rinse clean, and remove fabric or other contaminants



Junk Mail

- Place all junk mail in PLASTIC GROCERY SACKS ONLY
- MAGAZINES AND CATALOGS ARE OK TO RECYCLE.
