March 3, 2025

The Archbold Village Council met in regular session on Monday, March 3, 2025, at 5:30 p.m. in Council Chambers with the following members present: Gary Dominique, Kevin Eicher, Aaron Babcock, Chad Kern, and Karla Ball. Vaughn Bentz was absent. Mayor Brad Grime opened the meeting with a moment of silence and presided thereat.

RESOLUTION 2025-07: A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE UNIFORM AND CLOTHING ALLOWANCE PROGRAM FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ARCHBOLD AND REPEALING ALL PRIOR ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Councilwoman Karla Ball shared that some residents in North Pointe & Woodland Oaks I reached out to her concerning the utility flags and paint in their yards. Alt responded that a company is putting in high speed internet wiring and have gone through the proper channels with the engineering department. Ball added that she found the information afterward on the Ohio 811 Call Before You Dig website. Residents can also call or use the Ohio 811 phone app to see what's going on underground.
