

COUNCIL MINUTES

June 2, 2025

The Archbold Village Council met in regular session on Monday, June 2, 2025, at 5:30 p.m. in Council Chambers with the following members present: Gary Dominique, Vaughn Bentz, Kevin Eicher, Aaron Babcock, Chad Kern, and Karla Ball. Mayor Brad Grime opened the meeting with a moment of silence and presided thereat.

There being no corrections to the minutes of the May 19, 2025 Council meeting, Chad Kern moved to approve, seconded by Vaughn Bentz.

Councilwoman Karla Ball shared that the Archbold Community Garden's Blossom Bash was a nice community event. On the subject of the community garden, Village Administrator Aaron Alt added that a nearby resident has complained about light pollution from the newer lights above the garden's mural. The consensus of the Council was that the lights are within regulation and are an added security feature.
